

# Size of Wales KS2 Education Pack



**Diamond 9** for deciding what to do about deforestation. In groups, pupils cut out the cards and make a diamond shape with the idea they think is best at the top, and their least favourite at the bottom. Take one card out and replace it with a blank if you want pupils to think of their own idea.

Plant trees in your school grounds or in the local area	Invite your MP or assembly member to school to tell them about how to protect rainforests	Write to a shop and ask them if their wood comes from sustainable sources
Let people know how to buy wood from sustainable sources	Write to companies to ask if they use sustainable palm oil	Run a campaign to let people know about palm oil in goods we buy
Make a film to show to parents, or put it on a website	Raise money and donate it to a charity who works to help rainforests	Arrange to talk about deforestation on the radio, or send a press release to the newspaper
