

## What Can We Do?

For deciding what pupils can do about deforestation. Cut out the cards. In groups, pupils discuss the ideas and make a diamond shape with the idea they think is best at the top, and their least favourite at the bottom. Take some more cards out and replace them with blank cards if you want pupils to think of more of their own ideas.

Plant trees in your school grounds or in the local area	Invite your MP or Assembly Member to school to discuss how Wales can help to protect tropical forests	Write to a shop and ask them if their wood/food comes from sustainable sources
Let people know how to buy wood/food from sustainable sources	Write to companies to ask if they use sustainable palm oil	
Make a film to show to parents, or put it on a website	Raise money and donate it to a charity who works to help tropical forests	Arrange to talk about deforestation on the radio, or send a press release to the newspaper
